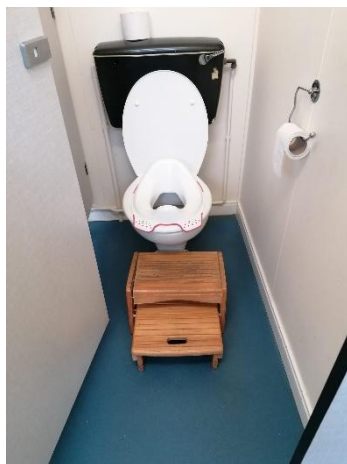


A member of staff will help you hang your bag and coat up on the pegs.

Then You will come into the bathroom and wash your hands before going into the hall.



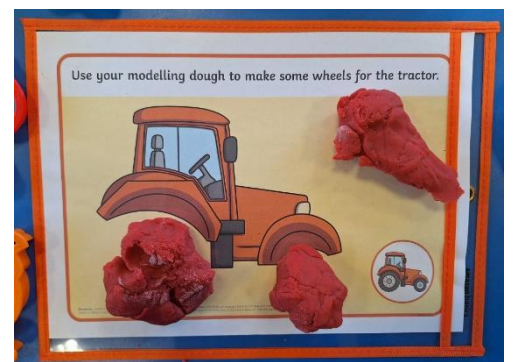
This is where you go to the toilet or have your nappy changed.

This helps us get to know you and ensure we have some activities and toys you would particularly like to play with when you first join us!



You will have lots of time to explore all the activities in the hall and the staff will be there to play with you and help you learn.

In the morning, we have snack time. You will be able to choose from a selection of fruit and vegetables, cheese and a carbohydrate like toast or pitta bread. You have the choice of milk or water to drink. We change the food choices each day and often have some special additions to the snack table when we learn about celebrations and festivals around the world, a great chance to try new foods!



After some time inside the hall and snack time, you get to play outside. We have lots of outdoor space we like to explore. We have other toys outside like bikes, climbing equipment, bats and balls, mark making equipment and much more!

If you stay for lunch, you will wash your hands before lunch and sit down with your friends to eat your lunch. You have your water bottle on your table, so you do not need an extra drink.



After lunch you can play in the hall. Sometimes we have special visitors to teach us some new things like French and Yoga! Then we go back outside to play.

At the end of the day/session, your parents and carers will line up by the side door to collect you.

Things you will need to bring to Pre School

- On hot days you will come in with sun cream already applied, staff will reapply sun cream but this must be provided and in your bag.
